

COMMITTEE AMENDMENT

[STAFF WORKING DRAFT]

Purpose: To provide that telephone numbers registered on the do-not-call list do not expire, but permit the Federal Trade Commission to delete those telephone numbers that have been disconnected and reassigned.

INTENDED to be proposed by Mr. DORGAN

Viz: Strike out all after the enacting clause and insert the following:

1 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

2 This Act may be cited as the “Do-Not-Call Improve-
3 ment Act of 2007”.

4 **SEC. 2. PROHIBITION OF EXPIRATION DATE FOR REG-
5 ISTERED TELEPHONE NUMBERS.**

6 (a) IN GENERAL.—The registration of a telephone
7 number on the do-not-call registry of the Telemarketing
8 Sales Rule (16 C. F. R. 310.4(b)(1)(iii)) shall not expire
9 at the end of any specified time period.

10 (b) REINSTATEMENT.—The Federal Trade Commis-
11 sion shall reinstate the registration of any telephone num-

1 ber that has been removed from the registry before the
2 date of enactment of this Act under a Federal Trade Com-
3 mission rule or practice requiring the removal of a tele-
4 phone number from the registry 5 years after its registra-
5 tion.

6 (c) REGISTRY MAINTENANCE.—The Federal Trade
7 Commission may check telephone numbers listed on the
8 do-not-call registry against national databases periodically
9 and purge those numbers that have been disconnected and
10 reassigned.
