1 **SEC. ____ . REPORT ON TARIFF AND NONTARIFF BARRIERS.**

2 Not later than 90 days after the date of the enact-
3 ment of this Act, the Secretary of Commerce, in consulta-
4 tion with the United States Trade Representative and
5 other appropriate entities, shall report to Congress on the
6 tariff and nontariff barriers imposed by Colombia, the Re-
7 public of Korea, and Panama with respect to exports of
8 firms in the United States, including small and medium-
9 sized manufacturing firms.
